Enrolment



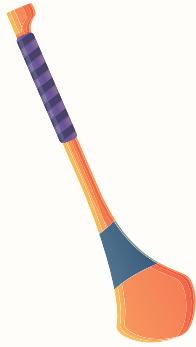
Dromindoora National School are still accepting new enrolments for the 2024-2025 Academic School year. Enrolment forms are available from the school office.
