Christmas Closure

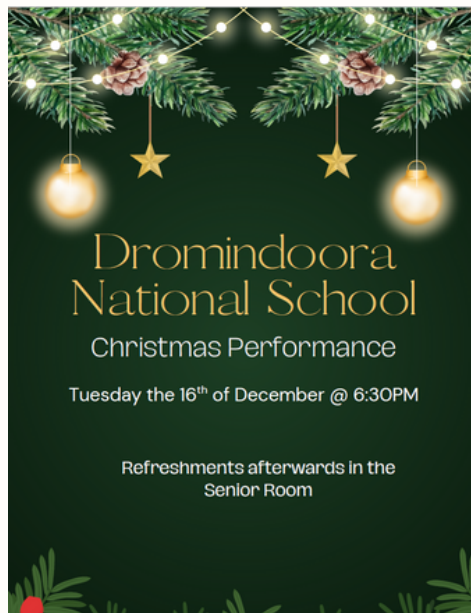
Dromindoora National School will close at 12pm on Friday the 19th of December. The school reopen on the 5th January 2026.
