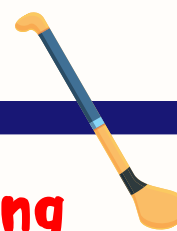
Dear parents/guardians,

Enrolment



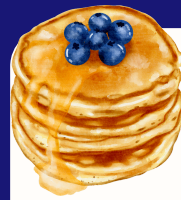
Dromindoora National School are now accepting new enrolments for the 2026-2027 Academic School year. Enrolment forms are available on request from the school office.
